Transporting Materials to the La Crosse County Landfill

As a service to local residents, La Crosse County accepts **tarped, secured loads** (*per County Ordinance 15.12*) of items such as bagged waste, furniture, bikes, grills, lawn mowers without gas and oil, mattresses, washers/dryers, clean drywall, doors, windows, sinks, toilets, tubs, roofing, carpets, and more at the Landfill site on Highway 16.

Safety on local roads and at the Landfill is a top priority. Materials not secured properly can fall out of trailers or vehicles, posing a risk for others. Plus, the Solid Waste Department or others must spend time clearing this litter and transporting materials to the right destination. If you plan to use the citizen drop-off area, think ahead. Make sure you have the right vehicle and materials to secure your load. **Beginning January 1, 2017, the County will charge \$5 for loads that are not tarped or secured correctly.** The charge will offset labor and other costs related to litter.
