

**NOTICE OF REFERENDUM
SCHOOL DISTRICT OF WEST SALEM**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that at an election to be held in the School District of West Salem on November 6, 2018, the following proposed Revenue Limit Resolution of the School Board will be submitted to a vote of the people:

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET TO EXCEED
REVENUE LIMIT FOR FOUR YEARS FOR NON- RECURRING PURPOSES**

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the School District of West Salem, La Crosse County, Wisconsin that the revenues included in the School District budget be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$1,600,000 for the 2019-2020 school year, by \$1,900,000 for the 2020-2021 school year, by \$2,115,000 for the 2021-2022 school year and by \$2,020,000 for the 2022-2023 school year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of maintaining educational programming and facilities.

The question will appear on the ballot as follows:

"Shall the School District of West Salem, La Crosse County, Wisconsin be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$1,600,000 for the 2019- 2020 school year, by \$1,900,000 for the 2020-2021 school year, by \$2,115,000 for the 2021-2022 school year and by \$2,020,000 for the 2022-2023 school year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of maintaining educational programming and facilities?"

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT AND EFFECT OF VOTE

The referendum election ballot will ask District electors to vote "yes" or "no" on the referendum election question as set forth above.

A "yes" vote on the question is a vote to authorize the School District of West Salem budget to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$1,600,000 for the 2019-2020 school year, by \$1,900,000 for the 2020-2021 school year, by \$2,115,000 for the 2021-2022 school year and by \$2,020,000 for the 2022-2023 school year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of maintaining educational programming and facilities.

A "no" vote on the question is a vote to deny the School District of West Salem the authority to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$1,600,000 for the 2019-2020 school year, by \$1,900,000 for the 2020-2021 school year, by \$2,115,000 for the 2021-2022 school year and by \$2,020,000 for the 2022-2023 school year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of maintaining educational programming and facilities.
