


The old highway plans show this location as the corner. Clayton Solberg had a 1979 survey showing this location as the corner. Joe Murphy used the spike as the corner in 1980. I do not know who set the railroad spike as the corner, but I accepted it as the best available evidence of the original government corner because it fits the occupied conditions and it has been used as the corner in previous survey work.


