SHELTER RESERVATION PROCEDURES

La Crosse County offers shelter house reservations for public use in three County parks. Each shelter includes electrical outlets, volleyball net, and an open grill. Vault toilets are located near each shelter. The shelter and its immediate surrounding area can accommodate a maximum of 150 people. If the group size is larger than this amount, one shelter is not large enough and other arrangements need to be addressed.

RATE: County Resident: The rental fee for a shelter is \$55 (2017 rate).
Non-County Resident: The rental fee for a shelter is \$60 (2017 rate).
Youth organizations: The rental fee is one half the regular fee for rentals Monday – Friday.

2017 SEASON: May 1st through September 30, 2017

HOURS: 8:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., Monday – Sunday

LOCATION: 5 shelters: Goose Island Park, W6488 County Rd. GI, Stoddard, WI
4 shelters: Veterans Memorial Park, N4668 County Rd VP, West Salem, WI
1 shelter: Neshonoc Park, W3373 State Road 16, West Salem, WI

NOTE: Shelter availability is limited after September 25th.
Please check with the Facilities Department for availability.

Reservations are accepted at the County Facilities Department beginning the first working day of each year during regular business hours. On the first working day of the year, reservations are accepted in person only. After the first working day, reservations can be made in person or by phone. All reservations are held for a maximum of 14 days without payment, after which any reserved date not secured by a payment will be made available for reservation once again. All reservations must be secured with a payment at least three (3) days prior to the date of use. Cancellation received by the Facilities Department at least 14 days prior to date of use will receive a partial refund of half the shelter rental fee.

All users of park facilities must agree to abide by the Park Rules and Regulations (Chapter 19 of the La Crosse County Code of Ordinances.)
