### FARMERS MARKET PERMITS

1. Only items produced by farmers on his/her own property or rented property may be sold. No wholesale products allowed.
2. Items eaten without peeling such as plums, cherries, apples, pears, peaches, carrots, radishes, lettuce, tomatoes must be protected from contamination and vermin during storage, transport and display.
3. Slicing or processing food is not permitted.
4. All scales must meet compliance with state codes.
5. Food such as meat, poultry, fish, dairy product or prepared food such as baked goods and candy may not be sold with a Farmers Market Permit. Other food processing licenses are required.
6. Sale of honey, maple syrup, and sorghum - Products must be sold in new, clean, approved containers. Reuse is prohibited. Products must be labeled with the following:  
Name of product  
Name and address of producer  
Net content (Weight)
7. Honey must be labeled with grade or be labeled ungraded. Products must be sold in new, clean, approved containers.
8. Farmers Market Permit must be posted in public view. The price of each item must be displayed.
