**Observed Violations - 11 - Individual water connections - DOC approved**

**OBSERVATION:** Water distribution system has not been approved by the department of commerce.

**CORRECTIVE ACTION(S):** Provide documentation to the department that the water distribution system is approved by the department of commerce.

**CODE CITATION:** DHS 178.12(2) INDIVIDUAL WATER CONNECTIONS. Plans for any water distribution system shall be approved by the department of commerce or its designated agent.

**Observed Violations - 23 - Containers for sewage approved - contents disposed of**

**OBSERVATION:** The waste water holding tanks are not approved by the department of commerce.

**CORRECTIVE ACTION(S):** Referral has been made to department of commerce plumbing inspector. Have a licensed plumber install State of Wisconsin approved waste water holding/transfer tanks.

**CODE CITATION:** (f) Containers installed outside of a camping unit and used to receive the discharge from its toilet, shower, bathing and sink facilities may be accepted by the department if approved by the department of industry, labor and human relations. Containers shall be emptied as often as necessary so as not to create a nuisance. Wastewater shall be disposed of in a manner approved by the department.

**Observed Violations - 33 - 1 per 300 or fraction**

**OBSERVATION:** No sanitary station is provided for new or expanded campground.

**CORRECTIVE ACTION(S):** Contact licensed plumber and install an approved sanitary dump station.

**CODE CITATION:** (1) All campgrounds accommodating independent camping units on unsewered sites shall provide a sanitary station in the ratio of 1 for every 300 sites or fraction thereof unless the operator submits a plan to the department and obtains an approval for an alternate method for disposal of liquid wastes.

**Observed Violations - 47 - Campground/facilities clean, safe, sanitary**

**OBSERVATION:** The campground is not being maintained in a clean, safe and sanitary condition at all times. There is much refuse and unused equipment on site.

**CORRECTIVE ACTION(S):** Maintain campground in a clean and safe condition.

**CODE CITATION:** (1) GENERAL. The campground operator shall maintain the campground and related facilities in a clean, safe and sanitary condition at all times.
