<p><b>Total # 3</b></p> <p><b>Observed Violations - 26 - Permissible patron load, Rescue equipment, first aid equipment, telephone present, located, good condition, phone numbers posted</b>  <b>OBSERVATION:</b> Ring buoy does not have rope long enough to meet code below.  <b>CORRECTIVE ACTION(S):</b> Provide a rope for the ring buoy that is 1.5 times max width of pool for the facility and mount it in a conspicuous location. Correct By: 12-May-2016  <b>CODE CITATION:</b> DHS 172.26 Rescue equipment. (1) REQUIRED EQUIPMENT. (b) For each basin of water over 4 feet in length and over 2 feet deep, a shepard's crook-type pole shall be provided. In addition, for each lifeguard chair, or for a pool 30 feet or more in width that does not have lifeguard</p>

chairs, at least one of the following shall be provided:

1. A ring buoy having a minimum outside diameter of 20 inches. Each ring buoy shall be attached to a 1/4 inch rope having a length not less than 1 1/2 times the maximum width of the pool or 50 feet, whichever is less.
2. A rescue tube.

**Observed Violations - 25 - Lifeguards identifiable, no distracting duties, at duties station, certifications verified**

**OBSERVATION:** Current lifeguard certification were not available at time of inspection. Operator did not know where the certificates were kept. Were not in pool office.

**CORRECTIVE ACTION(S):** The lifeguard must be relieved of duties until the certification can be verified. If the minimum lifeguard requirements in the approved staffing plan are not met as a result, the guarded pool or portion must be closed. Correct By: 12-May-2016

**CODE CITATION:** DHS 172.22 Lifeguards and Attendants. (2) QUALIFICATIONS. (a) A copy of each lifeguarding certification, first aid certification, and CPR certification held by lifeguard staff shall be maintained at the pool and shall be made available for inspection by the department.

**Observed Violations - 26 - Permissible patron load, Rescue equipment, first aid equipment, telephone present, located, good condition, phone numbers posted**

**OBSERVATION:** 2 durable blankets are not available in the pool area. 1 at time of inspection.

**CORRECTIVE ACTION(S):** Provide 2 durable blankets in the pool area. Correct By: 12-May-2016

**CODE CITATION:** DHS 172.27 First aid supplies. (1) A first aid kit of a sort approved by the department and 2 durable blankets in good condition shall be available at each pool area. The first aid kit shall contain all of the following items:

1. Gauze pads - 4" x 4",
2. Gauze pads - 8" x 10",
3. Adhesive bandages,
4. Triangular bandages,
5. Scissors,
6. Gauze roller bandage,
7. Tweezers,
8. Adhesive tape,
9. Eye wash,
10. Elastic bandage,
11. Disposable surgical gloves,
12. Resuscitation pocket face mask,
13. Instant cold packs.
