Observed Violations - 18 - Reusable equipment kept in covered stainless steel container and immersed in detergent or disinfectant solution until cleaned & sterilized.

OBSERVATION: Reusable equipment is not being stored in a covered stainless steel container with a cleaning or disinfectant solution in it.

CORRECTIVE ACTION(S): Store all reusable equipment in a covered stainless steel container of cleaning or disinfectant solution until they can be cleaned and sanitized. Correct By: 10-Jan-2014

CODE CITATION: DHS 173.14(1) CLEANING. (b) Reusable needles, tubes and body-piercing equipment shall be placed in a covered stainless steel container of cleaning or disinfectant solution until they can be cleaned and sterilized.

Observed Violations - 23 - Sterilization records including spore tests properly maintained.

CORRECTIVE ACTION(S): Maintain complete sterilization records, including spore test results, for at least one year. Use disposable needles and tubes until you get a good spore test is received. Once the spore test is received re-sterilize grips and tubes. Correct By: 13-Jan-2014
