General Information

Users of the La Crosse County Solid Waste Disposal System agree to be bound by all the applicable statutes, laws, ordinances, regulations and policies. Go to www.co.la-crosse.wi.us to see County ordinances. Failure to abide by said statutes, laws, ordinances, regulations, and policies will result in fines and penalties as outlined in State and County statutes, laws, ordinances, regulations, and rules.

Litter Control

All solid waste delivered to the Resource Recovery Facility (Xcel) or the La Crosse County Landfill are to be completely enclosed within the vehicle, either in a packer truck, enclosed box or trailer, or covered with a tarpaulin.

Amendment of Rules and Regulations

The Public Works & Infrastructure Committee reserves the right to amend these rules and regulations.

2016 Fees

The purchase of an annual (based on calendar year) or 3-day permit (permits are per vehicle), is required to use SOME areas of the La Crosse County Solid Waste Disposal System (includes Xcel Energy French Island Facility). The following are the current rates:

Unacceptable by tons (Large unacceptable loads)	\$102.78/ton

Friable and non-friable asbestos (including slate siding & slate roofing)	\$125/ton
Unacceptable appliances mixed in waste load	\$25/item
Unacceptable car tires mixed in waste load	\$4/item
Unacceptable E-waste mixed in waste load	\$25/item
Mattresses and Box Springs	\$15/each
Alternate daily cover material (Including carwash/sand grit and foundary sand)*	Call for specifics
Petroleum impacted soils*	Call for specifics
Other – special waste requests will be considered*	Call for specifics

Areas that DO NOT Require a permit

La Crosse County Landfill

Asphalt shingles (clean)	\$35/ton
Pallets and unpainted/untreated lumber (clean wood)	\$22/ton
Brush, limbs and stumps less than 18" in diameter	\$22/ton
Stumps over 18" in diameter	\$50/ton
Yard waste (Paper bags are allowed, plastic bags must be disposed of separately)	\$45/ton
Tires for recycling	\$250/ton

In the event the scale is inoperative at the sanitary landfill, a volumetric fee will be utilized based upon the maximum capacity of the truck.

Payment Terms and Past Due Accounts

Payment terms are EOM. A 1 1/2% interest charge per billing period will be charged on all accounts past due. Should a disposal bill remain unpaid after 2 billing periods, your account will be placed on hold until the balance is paid in full.
