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### ○ Hillview

- Weeding/cut back all shrubs in main courtyard and 700 courtyard
- Pressure wash the building and gazebos
- Paint 900 railing black & safety areas yellow.
- Plant bulbs and relocate prairie grass
- Clean up tree limbs
- Wash windows

### ○ Carroll Heights and Hillview Terrace

- Weed in courtyard
- West side along drive cut back overgrown shrubs

### ○ Cemetery

- Fix any broken stones
- Scatter garden
- Fence
- Weed around monument signs

# PROJECT UPDATE

- County board construction bids Aug 15
- Subcontractors have begun
- Ground Breaking on October 2
- Demo on 200-500 and framing just about done
- 100 getting ready for temporary transitioning
- Grant \$\$ allowing for start up costs/staff training for DCSU and allows for more upgrades to SNF areas

26 remodeled SNF rooms on west to become all private rooms.

The Oaks on 700 HALL, will have all resident rooms remodeled. A new SPA, office space and a public restroom are included in the renovations.

A new 35-bed Community Based Residential Facility (CBRF) providing care in a home-like setting,

A 4-bed crisis Dementia Crisis Stabilization Unit (CBRF) to meet a growing need in our community for specialized dementia care.

To make use of underutilized space at Hillview, we are adding:

An Intergenerational Day Center - a first for our region, will provide childcare and programming for older adults with mild to moderate dementia in an integrated setting.

10 units of supportive housing for those at risk for becoming unsheltered, will complement the city-county Pathways Home plan.

The estimated completion date for the project is December 2025.

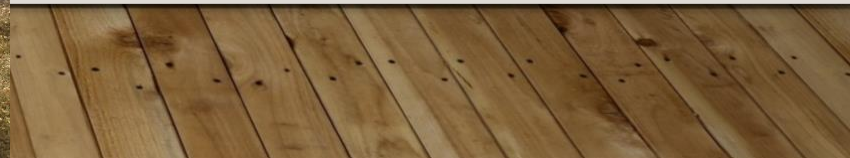
**The Hillview campus also includes** Carroll Heights, which has 55 affordable apartments for older adults, and Hillview Terrace, a 30-unit Residential Care Apartment Complex.













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## NEXT STEPS

FFE bids due 10/16/2024 (furniture pricing for all areas)

Intergenerational Provider Interviews Monday 10/21/24

CBRF Naming contest to begin next week; Process all residents/staff/families can participate. A committee will review and narrow down names ; Survey Monkey to narrow it to top 3. We will take recommendation to VALTC.

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## **NEXT STEPS**

Laundry Room relocated from basement to upstairs across from Recreation Room. Services will continue as they are currently.

Move Team will reconvene and letters to be sent out regarding temp relocation process

Beginning Mid November, we will use the 100 halls as a transition hall. Staff and residents will temp relocate for approx. 40 days while upgrades occur



# **RELOCATION PLANS – long term plan**

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**Submit plans after the  
first of the year**

There will be an **INDIVIDUALIZED** plan for each person who lives at Hillview

a **RELOCATION PLAN** for each resident, even if it is to stay in our SNF or relocate to our new CBRF.

A **TEAM** includes (Ombudsman, Relocation Specialist, Family Care representative, ADRC representative and HV representative and Resident/Family)

Plan will involve continual weekly assessing of each resident's preference, needs, and funding.

Purpose is to openly communicate so there are no surprises. Preferences and needs may change throughout this process
