

**NOTICE OF REFERENDUM
TOWN OF CAMPBELL
MAY 19, 2026**

Referendum Election Details

At an election to be held in the Town of Campbell on May 19, 2026, the following proposed Order for Incorporation of the Town will be submitted to a vote of the people:

WHEREAS the Incorporation Review Board approved the Petition for the Incorporation of the Town of Campbell as a Village in its determination dated March 25, 2026; therefore, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, that pursuant to §§66.0203(9)(f) and 6.0211(1), Stats., a referendum shall be held by the electors in the Town of Campbell to determine whether the Town shall incorporate as a Village on Tuesday, May 19, 2026.

Ballot Text

The question will appear on the ballot as follows:

Should the Town of Campbell be incorporated as a Village to be known as the Village of French Island?

- a. For a Village
- b. Against a Village

Explanation

The referendum election ballot will ask Town electors to vote "For a Village" or "Against a Village" on the referendum election question as set forth above.

A "For a Village" vote on the question supports the Town of Campbell incorporation to a village.

An "Against a Village" on the question opposes the Town of Campbell to incorporate to a village.

In the event a majority of the electors voting on the question vote "For a Village", the Town will be authorized to proceed with incorporation. If a majority vote "Against a Village" on the question set forth above, the Town will not be so authorized.
