WISCONSIN WELL WOMAN PROGRAM INCOME GUIDELINE CHANGES

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The Wisconsin Well Women Program (WWWP) announced new income guidelines effective February 1, 2024. The program pays for cancer screening for women, mammograms which screen for breast cancer, and a pap test screen for cervical cancer. To qualify for the program women must be age 40-64 years or age 35-39 years with breast symptoms or concerns, not have health insurance or have high deductible insurance, and have income within the income guidelines listed below.

New income guidelines:

Annual Gross (before taxes/deductions are removed) Household Income
Up to \$37,650
Up to \$51,100
Up to \$64,550
Up to \$78,000
Add \$13,450 for
each additional
family member
