Operating without a license is a violation of Wisconsin Law. If you have been operating without a license, you may be required to pay an operating without a license fee in addition to the license fee. Licenses are not transferable between persons or locations. Licenses expire annually on June 30th; unless issued after April 1st, which will expire on June 30th of the following year. The license fee is not prorated for partial license years. The Department or its agent may inspect premises at any reasonable time. Missing information may delay the issuance of your license. You cannot operate without a valid license issued by the Department or its agent. The undersigned hereby certifies that this is a true, complete and accurate application for the micro market license under <i>Wis. Stat. § 97.30</i>.</p> <p>Within 30 days after receiving a complete application for a license, the department or its agent shall either approve the application and issue a license or deny the application. If the application for a license is denied, the department or its agent shall give the applicant reasons, in writing, for the denial.
