Tobacco Compliance Checks

The Problem: Youth Tobacco Use



Over 8 in 10 adult smokers started before the age of 18

In La Crosse County...

L in **4**

high school students have ever tried vaping

52%

of high school students that vape or use other tobacco products have **tried to quit** in the last year

In 2023, **13%** of La Crosse County high schoolers regularly used e-cigarettes a rate comparable to conventional cigarette use among teens in 2013. **This is almost a decade of lost progress.**




Wisconsin WINS is dedicated to keeping commercial tobacco out of the hands of youth and stopping tobacco addiction before it ever starts.

La Crosse County Compliance Checks

Fast Facts about Wisconsin WINS

- La Crosse County conducts about 60 tobacco compliance checks each year.
- Compliance checks were paused during 2020-2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Since 2019, the number of retailers that failed their compliance checks has decreased. This means that more retailers are keeping tobacco out of the hands of minors.
- The federal Synar Amendment requires that all states keep a sales rate of less than 20% to minors. La Crosse County retailers are meeting the mark and denying sales to minors.
