- The Homeless Outreach Team continues their role in keeping our Pathways to Housing list up to date by going out into our community three times per week. Their hard work has reduced our "Current Living Situation Unknown" count from 101 last month to 53 this month allowing us to better serve and connect with our homeless population.
- The Pathways Home team is working with La Crosse IT to improve the efficiency and security of our Pathways to Housing list. This **business process review is making sure we continue to have an accurate and sustainable way to manage our by-name listing** of those needing housing over time.
- Weekly Pathways Conferencing continues through the great engagement of our community partners. 13 people on the Pathways to Housing list were housed in September and several more are awaiting housing move in dates—thank you team!
- The **City of La Crosse received 9 Specialized Housing Proposals**. These proposals will be reviewed and scored by both the Economic and Community Development Commission and the Pathways Home team for sustainability, feasibility, organizational experience, and alignment with Pathways Home plan. Final awards will be determined by the La Crosse City council in November.
