- Weekly Pathways Conferencing continues through the great engagement of our community partners. Additional names continue to be added to our Pathways to Housing list as we work to capture every person currently experiencing homelessness in La Crosse. 13 people on the Pathways to Housing list were housed in August—thank you team!
- The City of La Crosse released a Request for Proposals for Pathways
 Home Specialized Housing Solutions. We are seeking partners
 with innovative ideas for increasing bridge housing,
 permanent supportive housing, and other specialized
 housing supports. Proposals are due September 27. Growing our
 specialized housing capacity is a key component for Pathways Home
 success.
- Work continues to develop clear "service pathways" to secure housing for those facing common barriers. Our initial pathways include public housing, residential substance use treatment, and case management or housing navigation services. These step-bystep documents will ensure that community case managers have an efficient, streamlined, and predictable process for accessing various services. We are moving the first wave of people through the public housing navigation process to fully validate it.
- Jim Drees has onboarded as Pathways project leader. He brings extensive project management experience. We are reviewing current workstreams for how they are working and flowing and then adjusting them as needed. New project operating rhythms are being established to ensure effective project tracking and execution.
