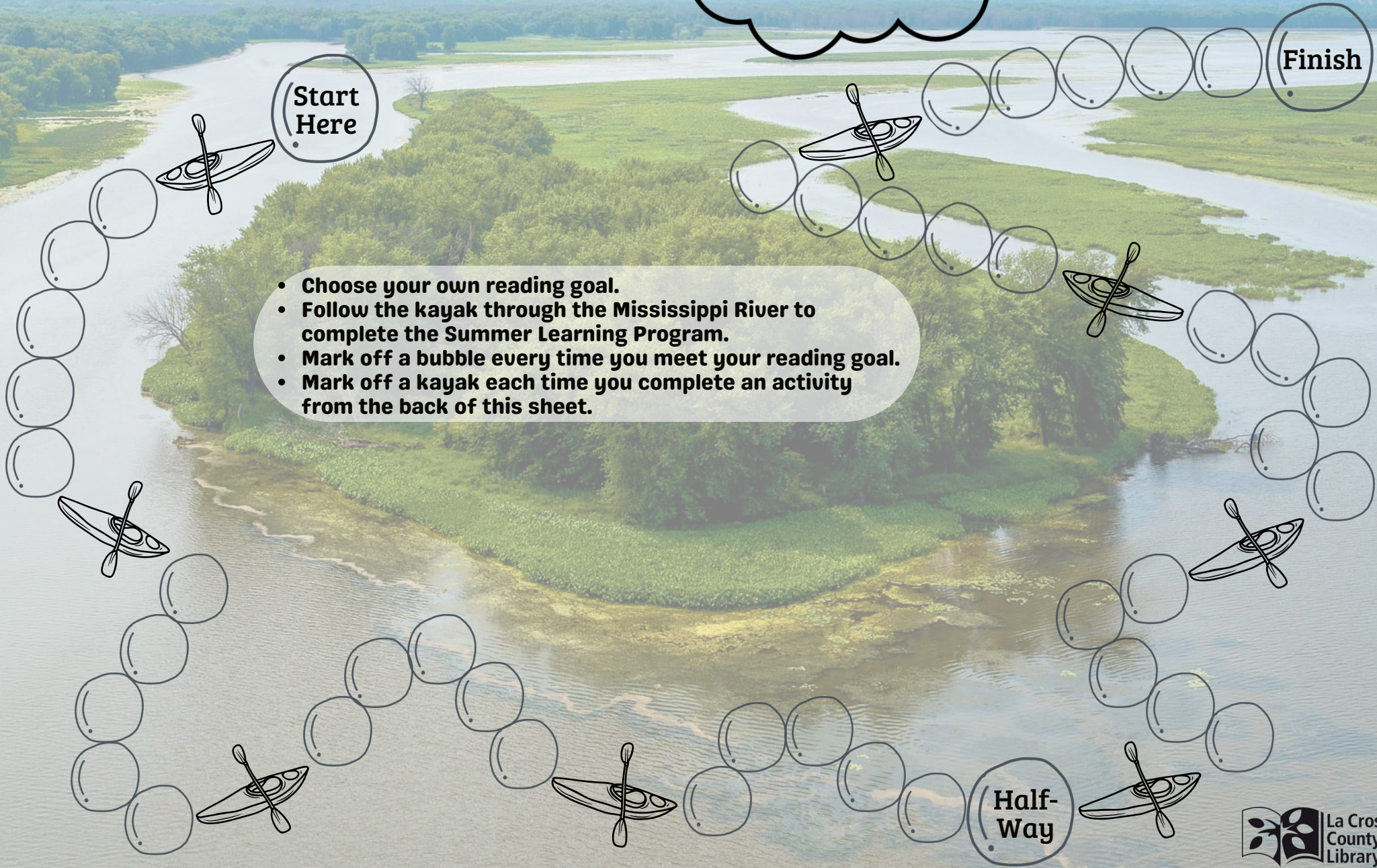


Read, Renew, Repeat

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?

- 1) Register on our website lacrossecountylibrary.org, at any of our five library locations, OR register on Beanstack and participate virtually!
- 2) Set your reading goal (do what works for you to keep you reading and exploring throughout the summer).
- 3) Start reading! Mark off a bubble each time you hit your reading goal and mark off a kayak each time you do one of the activities from the activity list.
- 4) Go to the Library when you reach the halfway point and when you finish to collect your prizes.
- 5) Complete and turn in your reading record on or before July 27, 2024.

READING GOAL EXAMPLES

Choose by time:

- Read ___ minutes a day.
- Read ___ hours a day.
- Have my grownup read to me ___ minutes every day.

Choose by book:

- Be read or read ___ books every day.
- Read ___ chapters a day.
- Read ___ pages every day.

Choose another motivator:

- Be read or read a different genre every week.
- Be read to or read in a different place every day or week.
- OR come up with your very own goal!



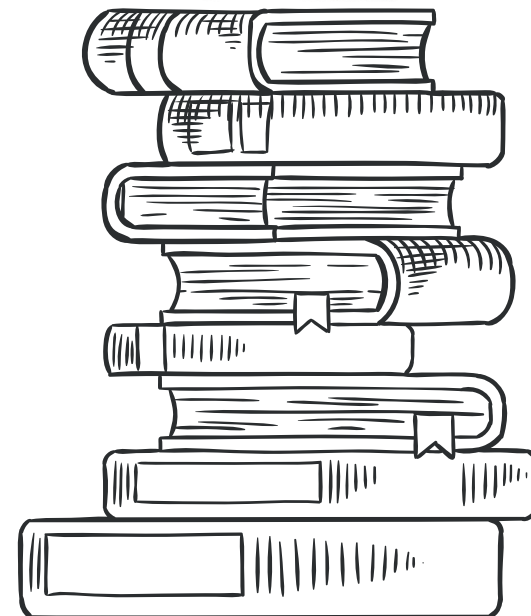
ACTIVITY LIST

Each time you do one of these activities, color in or mark off one of the kayaks on your reading record.

1. Explore Veteran's Memorial Park or Goose Island, and collect a temporary tattoo at the campground store while you're there.
2. Listen to an audiobook, a Playaway, or a Wonderbook--or a book on Hoopla or Libby, our library apps.
3. Write a story or draw a picture about helping the environment, and bring it to the library to display.*
4. Do our summer nature BINGO sheet. Grab one at any La Crosse County Library.*
5. Attend a library event.
6. Check out and read a magazine.
7. Put on a play with animal puppets.*
8. Read in a new place like under a tree or in a tent with a flashlight.*
9. Sing a song or make up your own.
10. Tell a librarian about a book you read.*
11. Create a diorama and a description of the scene to display at the library.* It can be a forest, underwater, desert, jungle, or other scene.
12. Create a recycling or compost bin for your home.*
13. Assemble a puzzle, or make your own by drawing a picture and cutting it into pieces.*
14. Explore a new park or trail (check out our free passes to WI state parks, while supplies last).
15. Complete a Creation Station project, available at all of our five locations.*
16. Check out a Family Fun Bag.
