CALL TO ORDER

Chair Patrick Barlow called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. Roll call was taken and a quorum was called.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF THE JULY 19, 2023 LAPC MEETING

MOTION by Poellinger/Hauser to approve the minutes of the July 19, 2023 La Crosse Area Planning Committee meeting. **Motion carried unanimously.**

APPROVE AMENDING THE 2023-2026 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The La Crosse Area Planning Committee approved the 2023-2026 TIP on November 16, 2022. Since adoption of the TIP, two (2) projects have been added to the TIP projects list: 243-23-030 CTH OT, STH 35 - CTH SN, Pavement Replacement, Design Obligated in 2023, with Construction Anticipated in 2026; 243-23-031 Holland Bluff Trail, Town of Holland (Bluffview Ct. to Sylvester Rd.), Multi-Use Path, Design Anticipated in 2024, Construction Anticipated in 2025. 53 projects are being amended/changed.

MOTION by Poellinger/Hauser to approve. Motion carried unanimously (two excused Kapanke, Candahl).

APPROVE LAPC ADJUSTED URBANIZED BOUNDARY

The Wisconsin and Minnesota Departments of Transportation, every 10 years following the release of decennial census data, lead a process to adjust Census-defined Urban Area Boundaries (UABs) within their states, in conjunction with their respective offices of the Federal Highway Administration. After review by LAPC staff, the LAPC Technical Advisory Committee, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, the Minnesota Department of Transportation, and the Federal Highway Administration, the proposed adjusted Urban Area Boundary has been found to be justified.

MOTION by Kruse/Poellinger to approve. Motion carried unanimously (two excused Kapanke, Candahl).

APPROVE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SAFETY TARGETS

Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) must annually establish calendar year targets for each of the five HSIP performance measures by either agreeing to plan and program projects so that they contribute to the accomplishment of State HSIP targets or commit to quantifiable HSIP targets for the metropolitan planning area. The La Crosse Area Planning Committee agrees to plan and program projects that support the following WisDOT 2024 HSIP targets:
