COVID UPDATE

HOW TO STAY CONNECTED

General Information

- We will continue to screen for symptoms of COVID-19 upon entry for all visitors. Each visitor, over 2 years of age, will be given a well-fitting surgical mask upon entry.
 - ◊ *Residents that are fully vaccinated may remove their mask during the visit when in their room.*
- Visits can be held in the resident's room, but private visiting spaces will still be available. Visitors may not interact with other residents at this time in the general household spaces.
- Scheduling is no longer required, but we do encourage visitors to notify us in advance if possible.

Outdoor Visitations

- With summer almost upon us, outdoor visits are still the safest. These visits can more easily accommodate larger groups of visitors.

Virtual Visitations

- We still have I-Pads available. Schedule your virtual visit today!

Indoor Visitations

- Although we will not be limiting the number of visitors each of our residents may receive, we recommend that there are no more visitors present at one time than can comfortably fit into the room when social distancing
- There will be no time limit to the visit, and there are no age restrictions.
- Please continue to be vigilant and assist with room disinfection after the visit

Vaccinations

There is still time! Currently over 90% of the Assisted Living Residents are vaccinated. If you would like for your loved one to receive the COVID vaccination, please contact the Household Coordinator or the Community Living Supervisor.
